Choosing Wisely Canada launched STARS in November 2015 with a **Leadership Summit** attended by 2 students from each of Canada's 17 medical schools.

1878 Canadian students contributed to "Six Things Medical Students & Trainees Should Question" - a Choosing Wisely list for medical education.

82% of STARS student leaders planned or implemented a change in their medical school curriculum to integrate resource stewardship content.

60% of STARS student leaders implemented initiatives (e.g. Interest Groups, Campaign Week, Journal Clubs) to stimulate conversation about resource stewardship.

Initiatives implemented by STARS student leaders at their schools reached over **2000** Canadian medical students.

STARS formed a national community of practice unifying students with a shared passion for resource stewardship and innovation in medical education.
